The RCMP's Community-Industry Response Group (C-IRG) is now the Critical Response Unit (CRU-BC)—but this is just a PR stunt to cover up years of violence against Indigenous land defenders

THIS IS STATE VIOLENCE IN DISGUISE

Militarized Force Against Indigenous Sovereignty

- C-IRG targets Indigenous resistance to pipelines and resource extraction.
- Wet'suwet'en & Fairy Creek & other defenders face excessive force, surveillance, and arrests.
- RCMP documents show fear of Indigenous resistance, modeled after Standing Rock.

Rebranding = Dodging Accountability

- Wet'suwet'en Chief Na'Moks calls it a tactic to avoid scrutiny.
- RCMP under federal investigation for civil rights violations.
- "Mission drift" criminalizes broader Indigenous sovereignty movements.

At least TEN Indigenous Canadians were killed by police in 2024, including shootings, being struck by police vehicles, and deaths in custody, though the true number may be higher due to inconsistent reporting and lack of transparency.

DEMAND ACTION

EXPOSE the RCMP's ongoing abuses.
DEFEND Indigenous land and sovereignty.
END the criminalization of Indigenous resistance.
