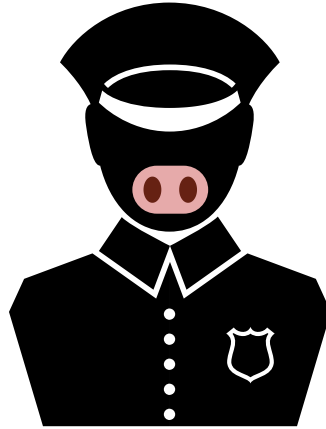


DON'T TALK TO PIGS & DON'T POST ARRESTS: PROTEST SAFETY 101



Police routinely look at social media and online messages for evidence when building a case.

Cops rely on *Open Source Intelligence* (OSINT), the collection of public records, including social media content, for investigative purposes - like arresting you **AFTER** an interaction with them, **OR** finding additional charges to lay against you and your comrades.

- Filming arrests is helpful in documenting police abuse & brutality, but can be HARMFUL for your comrades.
- DON'T post arrests without consent.
- If you aren't sure, DON'T post!
- OBSCURE faces, voices, clothing & any identifying features.
